

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Is there a fee to submit an application?

Yes. A non-refundable application fee of **\$50** is required at the time a membership application is submitted.

## What is the cost to join if my application is approved?

Upon acceptance, new members are required to pay a **\$1,000 initiation fee**.

## What are the annual dues?

Annual membership dues are **\$376.98**.

## What are the work hour requirements?

Each regular member is required to complete **30 work hours per year**.

New members are required to complete work hours at the rate of **2.5 hours per month**, beginning the month following their acceptance into the Club and continuing through the remainder of their first year of membership.

## Are dock slips available?

Dock slips are assigned at the Club's annual dock meeting, which is held each April.

Dock slips are **not guaranteed** and are assigned based on an established seniority system.

The maximum vessel length permitted is **34 feet**.

## Who is eligible for membership?

Any person **18 years of age or older** may be considered for membership, provided they are nominated by an active member in good standing. A member sponsor is therefore required.

Candidates for membership must be approved by a **majority vote of the active members present at a membership meeting**, in accordance with the procedures established in the Club's Bylaws.

The Club is limited to a maximum of **150 regular members** at any given time.

## **Can a non-member operate a jointly owned vessel at Club facilities?**

If a member co-owns a vessel with a non-member, the non-member may only operate the vessel at Club facilities when accompanied by the member co-owner.
